## ACCESSIBILITY AT DAVID GEFFEN HALL

**Pick-up/Drop-off:** Columbus Avenue at 64th Street

**Accessible Entry:** Accessible through automated doors from the Josie Robertson Plaza, via the accessible ramp on the corner of West 65th Street and Columbus Avenue and from the accessible parking area in the Lincoln Center Park-and-Lock Garage. Elevators on the concourse level, located to the left of the Cork Gallery from the West 65th Street entrance to the garage, provide access to the David Geffen Hall Box Office, Josie Robertson Plaza, and all levels of the concert hall. Security guards are posted in the area and available to assist guests.

**Directions from Drop-off Point to Parking:** Take Columbus Avenue to 62nd street and make a right turn then half way down the bloc turn right into the parking entrance and follow directions to regular or handicap parking.

**Accessible Seating:** Wheelchair accessible locations and designated aisle transfer seats are available throughout the theater. Wheelchairs, walkers, and canes may need to be stored during performances if they are obstructing the aisles. Ushers will mark and store mobility devices and return to patrons at intermission and the conclusion of the performance. Wheelchair Loans available for people who require a wheelchair to go to and from their seat. To arrange a loan, subject to availability, call Lincoln Center Security at 212.875.5520.

**Restrooms:** Accessible men's and women's restrooms on plaza and orchestra levels. Accessible unisex restrooms on each tier.

**Water Fountains:** All levels of hall. Cups available.

**Assistive Listening Devices:** Infrared assistive listening devices (headsets and neck loops) available. See the House Manager on the orchestra level. A valid photo ID is needed to ensure return.
